Mission

The mission of Mentoring Plus is to empower disadvantaged youth and their families to fulfill their potential and to contribute to the well-being of the community by forming relationships based on mutual trust, compassion, and respect.

What we do is is not easy. We build relationships with youth (13-21) who have long-term exposure to neglect, abuse, mental illness, violence, and other serious risk factors.

By building authentic and caring relationships with youth and their families, we allow them to "buy in" to our proven strategies and models - so they can make real, lasting changes in their lives.

Our site-based model gives youth and volunteer mentors a highly structured program with meals, life skill activities, recreational activities, and tutoring. This unusual model gives volunteers and youth a safe place to spend time, with the constant guidance and support of professional staff.



That means they can focus on their relationship, not the logistics.


